We will review and accept applications on a rolling basis. All scholarship applicants will hear back from LandPaths no later than May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Please note that filling out this application is the first step of the process and does **not** guarantee that you will be awarded a scholarship. If you are awarded a scholarship, it is required that participants register and attend all days of the camp. Thank you for your application.
